Introduction

In this 9-page doctrine catalog, I have categorized the most fundamental doctrine of the Authorized King James Bible in logical order, as a Bible study help to believers. The purpose of this document is to make the sword of the Spirit, the Word of God, more readily available to brethren in doctrinal discussion, as well as to help those who have less available time for Bible study to quickly access the fundamental doctrines of the Christian faith, according to the scriptures.

The doctrine of the Bible is the doctrine of Christ. We can be certain that the Bible's doctrine is correct. Yet, much of the doctrine of the denominations and their pastors today does not run parallel with the true doctrine of the Bible. I have recognized this through 9 years of exclusively King-James-based Bible study. Today, if men go to the churches to get their doctrine, they are not hearing the doctrine of the Bible.

Such essential doctrine as the true gospel, works, salvation, and grace, ultimate salvation, reprobation and apostasy, the free will of man and his ability to choose the narrow or the broad way, are not preached as they truly are in the vast majority of churches today. But, there is good news: we can be certain of the truth by going directly to the doctrine of the Bible.

Final Thoughts to Consider About These Doctrines

The apostles used specific words with specific meanings in the original letters. Those words are consistently the same in 95% of manuscripts God promised to preserve His word, and He has. The minority manuscripts disagree in thousands of places, with no logical conformation of doctrine. These minority manuscripts were used for translating all recent English bibles. We are in the great falling away Paul warned about.

Two Received Text Bibles are the Authorized King James in English, and the Valera 1602 Purificada in Spanish. The Authorized King James Bible is unique in the English language in that it is a Received Text, not critical text, Bible and so I very strongly encourage you to base your doctrine on it 100%.

Appendix A - Detailed Information on “#’d” Doctrines

- #1 *An Example Prayer to Receive Jesus Christ as your Savior: “Lord God, I believe that Jesus Christ is Your Son, and that He rose again to life after dying on the cross. I want to live for you as a Christian. Please guide me. Thank you, Lord. Amen.”*
- #2 *Further doctrine shows that there is initial justification and justification by doing works of the Spirit. See the next two doctrine sections.*
- #3 *Some false brethren are reprobates who are convinced they are apostate. Yet, they could re-dedicate their lives to God and the gospel of Christ, and be redeemed.*
- #4 *Critical Texts include the NIV, NASV, RSV, NKJV, and others in English. There are corrupt, changed “bibles” in every major language. In English, only the Authorized King James Version is true to the original words of the apostles, the Received Text.*
- #5 *The great danger of false doctrines is that they diverge those who hold to them off of the narrow way, leading them to hell rather than eternal life. “For lack of knowledge my people perish” - Christians believe the lies they are taught by evil men, and they do not go to the Bible for truth; so, they end up not knowing the Way of truth – the narrow way, which alone leads to life. The Bible is full of warnings about this; men who go to true Received Text Bibles come to recognize that this is what they teach. The reality is, there is a narrow way, and there is a broad way, and only the narrow, hard, persecuted way leads to life. If men are not following God’s lead on the narrow way, they are not being children of God.*
- #6 **On Calvinism:** *Calvinism in essence is a system of belief based on gnosticism which is not supported by scripture, yet many denominations take it as the gospel. Mainly, they claim that man is completely evil, and therefore man must be controlled by God to do any good. They claim that God arbitrarily chooses who to save without any moral basis, (they say, since man is 100% evil, God simply chooses among man who to save based on no merit of the man), and man has no personal ability or choice to be saved. These Calvinist teachings are not in any way biblical.*
- #7 *The “trinity”, defined as the doctrine that God and Jesus are the same person, in any applicable sense.*
- #8 **Denominationalism:** *Just as in Jesus’ time there were men who made themselves religious leaders claiming to be God’s teachers of those in the faith, today there are men who rule whole sects of religious belief based on the doctrines they spread. Yet, those doctrines are nowhere to be found in the Received Text, true Christian Bibles that go back all the way to the original letters of the apostles. These men do what the Pharisees in Jesus’ time did. They teach for doctrines the commandments of men, not of God. So, ask yourself, should we serve man, or God? Should we spread God’s truth, or man’s false version of the truth? Spreading the false doctrines of denominations actually damns many who hear and become subservient to those false doctrines. They never serve God, they serve false teachers, so Jesus will tell them on the Judgment Day, “I never knew you.” Matthew 15:3-14*
- #9 **On “Making Disciples”** - *the Received Text never states that we are called to “disciple” believers. A regular argument of church belief is that church is the only place where believers can “be disciplined”, that is, grow as believers. The Bible states otherwise: **God** is who we go to to be taught and raised up in the faith; we go to no man before we go to God. Religious leaders of the world teach for doctrines the commandments of men: the “make disciples” command comes from a critical text Bible, in Matthew 28:19, where the Koine Greek word for “teach” is supplanted by the English non-equivalent words “make disciples”. In God’s biblical tradition, the key difference is that we teach without claiming authority over those we teach. Churches commonly expect their followers to obey men in positions of political influence - the “pastors”. But, men who teach following God’s tradition in the true Received Text Bibles do not expect men to give them submission to any “authority” of theirs – they simply teach, and learn along with all of the other brethren. Paul stated that “we are helpers in your joy”, not men which “have dominion over your faith” - 2Co 1:24. “make disciples”, and therefore, “you must go to a church,” is not biblical. All Christians are Jesus’ disciples – no other man’s.*
- #10 *Consider the persecution of Paul, of Stephen, of all of the apostles. Consider the persecution of Christian leaders in atheist countries like China and Russia, where leaders die and are tortured for guiding the flock of Christ. Then, consider the comfort and lack of persecution of men who teach doctrines not found in the Bible, for dishonest gain and status. Those who teach true doctrine from the Received Text (the AKJV in English) are rejected from churches in the USA in the majority. Unfortunately, the leaders in the USA are very often wolves in sheep’s clothing, or very misguided men who went to colleges, not God, to reach their positions of political influence in the churches. When true brethren teach the truth contained in Received Text Bibles, like the truth about grace not meaning you can sin, or that eternal security is error, or that you must do God’s good works He leads you to to be saved, or that many “bibles” are full of changed, errant doctrine, and they speak out about these truths in the churches, religious leaders here push them away from their churches, even calling them heretics because they don’t follow that denomination’s errant doctrine. But, the truth of the Bible stands.*
